

## Update October 26, 2020 METRO MELBOURNE

### Summary of the Third Step and further easing of restrictions

Under the Third Step, and from 11:59pm on Tuesday, Melbourne will move from “stay home” to “stay safe”, with no more restrictions on the reasons to leave home.

- **Indoor religious gatherings:** Allowed for up to 10 people, plus one faith leader
  - Strict requirements to be contained in a COVID Safe Plan
  - Can only have one gathering at a time whether indoor or outdoor
- **Outdoor religious gatherings and ceremonies:** up to 20 people, plus 1 faith leader, proximate to a place of worship
  - Can only have one gathering at a time whether indoor or outdoor
- **Private worship:** allowed for a household, and two adults and any of their children or dependents, plus a faith leader
- **Weddings:** up to 10 people, including couple and two witnesses, celebrant and one photographer excluded from cap
- **Funerals:** up to 20 people, people to conduct funeral and infants under 12 months not included in cap
