Statement from the Premier

Metropolitan Melbourne will be in the **Second Step** Towards <u>COVID Normal</u> from 11:59pm on 27 September.

- Curfew: does not apply from 5am 28 September 2020
- **Religious ceremonies broadcast:** a maximum of 5 people can attend a place of worship to conduct ceremony being broadcast.
- Outdoor religious gatherings and ceremonies: permitted with a limit of five people, plus one faith leader. Must be adjacent to the place of worship with only one group permitted at a time. Sharing of food, drink, crockery, utensils, vessels or other equipment by participants is not permitted.
- **Weddings** permitted in outdoor public spaces with a maximum of 5 attendees, including the couple and two witnesses, but not including the celebrant. Weddings do not need to occur proximate to a place of worship.
- Face coverings: A face covering means a face mask that covers the nose and mouth. Face shields on their own do not meet these requirements. There will be a one-week grace period in enforcement.
- **Funerals:** up to 10 people, plus infants under 12 months and people to conduct funeral
