

Update June 2,2021 - COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS FROM 11.59PM THURSDAY 3 JUNE

7-day circuit breaker restrictions summary

On the advice of Chief Health Officer Brett Sutton, the current lockdown restrictions will remain in place in Melbourne for a further seven days, with some small changes, giving a full 14 days or a full cycle of the virus.

Statement from the Acting Premier

Note: Cleaning, signage, record keeping, and other COVIDSafe requirements continue to apply for all venues and facilities with onsite operations as per Workplace Directions. The Density Quotient (DQ) applies to all venues and spaces that are accessible to the public (and in closed workplaces, to shared spaces such as lunchrooms).
