Category Reasons to leave home	<ul> <li>Restrictions</li> <li>Shopping for necessary goods and services,</li> <li>Authorised work or permitted education,</li> <li>Exercise, a 2-hour limit with one other person,</li> <li>Care giving, compassionate, and medical reasons</li> <li>To get vaccinated.</li> </ul>
	you cannot travel more than 5km from your primary residence, but there are some exemptions.
Wearing of Face Masks	These exemptions are: to access necessary goods and services if they are not available within your 5km zone, to visit an intimate partner, to visit a person in your "single bubble", to go to your permitted work or education, to work at an interstate location (where permitted by the other state) or for care and compassionate reasons.  The face mask requirement applies to everyone in Victoria aged 12 years and older
	· Masks must be carried at all times and worn indoors and outdoors, except when at home
Work restrictions	<ul> <li>Exemptions do apply, including when drinking and eating, exercising or for approved health reasons</li> <li>You are permitted to leave home to attend work if you cannot do so from home and you work in a permitted workplace</li> </ul>
School and Childcare Restrictions	<ul> <li>If you can do your office job from home, you need to work from home</li> <li>Closed, but open to vulnerable children</li> <li>Open to students with working parents with no other options can go to school</li> </ul>
Public gathering	<ul><li>Childcare and kindergarten are open</li><li>Public gathering is not allowed</li></ul>

#### Home visitors' restrictions

· No, unless it is deemed essential care

· Partners living separately can visit each other at home.

Religious and places · Weddings: are only permitted for deportation or end-of-life reasons. Limits also apply. Only five people (including the two persons being married, the celebrant and the witnesses) can attend.

- Funerals: limited to 10 people. Infants aged under 12 months do not apply to this cap.
- · Religious services will be broadcast only. Maximum 5 people for the broadcasting
