Update 11/05/21 – Density limits lift on small to medium-sized venues

From 28 May, places of worship less than 400 square metres can host gatherings of up to 200 people per space, without any density limit. It's recommended to have COVID marshals on site to ensure all visitors are checking in via the free Victorian Government QR Code Service at each space. Larger spaces will still need to observe density limits of 1 per 2sqm. Moreover, using of QR Codes is mandatory.
