Travel limit does not apply:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• to access necessary goods and services where those goods and services cannot be accessed closer than 25kms from home</li> <li>• to visit an intimate partner</li> <li>• to visit a person in your “single bubble”</li> <li>• for work and education</li> <li>• work at an interstate location (where permitted by another state)</li> <li>• care and compassionate reasons (specific exemptions apply)</li> </ul> <p>You cannot travel to regional Victoria, except for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• work or education</li> <li>• necessary goods and services (if they cannot be accessed within 25km of home)</li> <li>• care and compassionate reasons</li> <li>• to receive COVID-19 vaccination at the nearest vaccination centre to home</li> </ul>
