

APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR

Please behave appropriately for a Christian Convention. Loud offensive behaviour, drugs, and alcohol will not be tolerated.

Camp is not to be used to further business activities. Campers and Day Visitors are asked not to distribute, sell, or canvass anything that has not be authorised by conference administration.

Ball games and other such activities should be played in a safe way to avoid damage or injury.

CHILD SAFETY AND CHAPERONES FOR UNDER 18'S

It is essential that you are aware of your child's whereabouts at all times.

Under 18's must have a chaperone at night. Chaperones must regularly check in with those under their care and ensure that their tents and close environment areas are kept clean and tidy at all times.

FIRE AND GAS BOTTLES

Tents are flammable so please ensure that light bulbs and other hot surfaces are a safe distance from tent walls and are switched off when unattended.

All LP gas bottles used by campers must be **undamaged** and **stamped** with a **current** test date (not more than 10 y/o). Out of date bottles will not be allowed on site. **Spot checks will be conducted** and any expired gas bottles will be confiscated as a safety measure.

FIRST-AID AND HAZARDS

In case of a life threatening emergency where you have called 000, please notify the First Aid Officers who will attend the situation until the Ambulance arrives.

For non-threatening emergencies, call the First-Aid Officers.

Please report any dangerous incidents or hazards to the Camp Office.

NOISE CURFEW

Noise levels are to be kept at a **minimum** between **10:30PM** and **6:00AM**. Please use discretion outside of these times.

AUTHORISED PHOTOGRAPHY

Authorised photographers on premises will be identifiable with **an ID Lanyard/Pass.** Photographs and videos taken may be used during the camp program, for Conference promotions, and in print or on the web. If this poses an issue, please discuss this with the Camp Office.

PRE-BOOKED MEALS

Meal Tickets have been included in your Registration/Welcome Packs. **Meals are to be collected at the Catering Pavilion.**

DRINKING WATER

Drinking taps can be found around the camp site. As a general rule, 1/2 inch taps provide drinking water. 1 inch taps are not for drinking.

CAR PARKING

Cars are to be parked appropriately and **in permitted areas only.** Provided that there is room and you do not use your vehicle, it may remain parked at your camping site for the duration of the camp Limited access parking permits may be issued by Head of Security if required.

ROAD RULES

If your vehicle has a permit for limited driving on grounds, please use the outer roads where possible and keep your speed at a walking pace.

If you do not have a permit, DO NOT DRIVE.

BICYCLES

Bicycles are permitted on site but a **helmet must be worn at all times**. We also ask that you **lock** your bike when it is not in use.

VALUABLES

Please ensure that all valuables are cared for properly and not left unattended in tents/caravans.



Through 'More Service, More Prayer, More Community, More Worship, and beyond', we're leaning into the power of love expressed in deeper, bolder ways.






